MERCY MINISTRIES:

Mercy Ministries is a product of individuals touched and envisioned by the Holy Spirit. As CLA began to develop as a Christ centered community, a small group of men and women began to seek ways to reach out to those who had often been forgotten by a society that wanted to 'move on' from the past. Finding housing and skills training for widows with HIV, often with children in tow, is where this ministry expresses itself. So far three homes have been established with more envisioned.

HEALTH AND WELLNESS CENTER:

Health and wellness are basic issues taken for granted in much of the world. In Rwanda, these matters have been left to chance as the country has been focusing on recovering from war and on development. CLA has opened a brand new Health and Wellness Centre to provide free help to those needing help with basic hygiene and health. This clinic is in the process of being built and will be completed by the end of 2009. This will also include a birthing and medical clinic.

Christian Life Assembly, Kigali is a church which was planted in 1998 under the leadership of Elmer and Sherry Komant. From meeting under a tent for over seven years to a thriving congregation of around 800 strong, this international church is the hub for several key areas in helping Rwanda find hope through Jesus Christ. Listed on these pages are three of the most significant ...

VOCATIONAL TRAINING:

The government of Rwanda provides free education for children right up to grade six. Insufficient secondary schools and expensive private schools eliminate over 60 percent of children from gaining further education. After grade six, most children are on their own. CLA is currently in the process of raising the necessary funds to build a vocational training centre for the marginalized and underprivileged cannot attend secondary school primarily because of affordability. Skills such as welding, construction, electrical and woodwork to basket weaving and sewing are areas that will help young Rwandans find their place in society.
